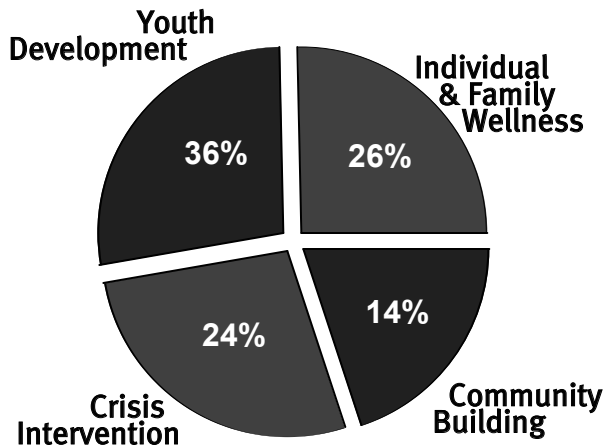


Crown Point

For the year 2009, 33 diverse agencies will provide more than 39 services to men, women and children throughout Lake County, Indiana.

Some Interesting Statistics About Crown Point

There are **3** Lake Area United Way agencies located in Crown Point -- St. Jude House, Southlake YMCA and Catholic Family & Community Service, which performed over **6,447** services to residents.

In addition, a total of **2,394** youth received services that promote character and spiritual growth through groups such as the Boy and Girl Scouts, the Boys & Girls Clubs, NWI CYO and the Summer Enrichment for Students with Disabilities.

Meals on Wheels provided a hot lunch to **231** residents of Crown Point.
