The House is a transitional residential home for women who have desire to work and gain an education and need a place to stay. Four adult females some with small children will be the residents. They will have jobs and education and in-home therapies.

House Manager Benefits

- Free food, clothing, and housing and independent room in 4-bedroom home.
- Free mental health and outpatient medical care

House Manager Qualifications

Preferred qualifications to be mature and responsible female with or without experience in working with adults and willing to stay overnight.

Skills suggested to help in the position r

- A. Trustworthy and responsible
- B. Good interpersonal communication
- C. Team player and participate in a multidisciplinary team

Specifics include

- Stay overnight (can have time off to shop, visit family due to interns)
- HS Diploma or Equivalent if possible.
- Background check per Indiana standards
- Respect and implement the house rules
- Ability to create clear and open lines of communication between herself and residents to ensure that all needs and problems are handled quickly and efficiently
- Assist the Program Supervisor with scheduling appointments as needed
- Monitor the supervision of residents (entry, exit)
- Be able to listen and develop a healthy relationship with residents with clear boundaries
- Report to the T.H.R.I.V.E. supervisor
- Abide by the policies and procedures of the T.H.R.I.V.E. program
- Submit resident evaluations
- Maintain confidentiality, follow protocols for care, help in coordinating services
- Pick up/Drop off residents to and from work
- Pick up food from pantry
- Help meal prep with residents
